Local Law No. 1 of 2011 entitled "A Local Law Creating Chapter 202 of the Village Code 'Homestead Base Proportions and Non-Homestead Base Proportions'" This local law will establish the use of the homestead base proportions under New York State Real Property Tax Law § 1903, within the Village.

Local Law No. 2 of 2011 entitled "A Local Law for Recomputation of Eligible Funds Exemptions Based On Change Of Level In Assessment." This local law would provide for the recomputation of the Veterans Exemption known as the Eligible Funds Exemption under RPTL § 458 as a result of the reassessment and revaluation of properties within the Village.

Local Law No. 3 of 2011 entitled "A Local Law Amending Section 201-17 Dealing With the Senior Citizen Tax Exemption." This local law will clarify and amend certain provisions of the senior citizens tax exemption within the Village.

Local Law No. 4 of 2011 entitled "A Local Law amending §201-25(A) dealing with the Alternate Veterans Exemption." This local law clarifies the application of the alternate veteran's exemption within the Village of Williston Park.

Local Law No. 5 of 2011 entitled "A Local Law Amending § 201-25(B) dealing with the Cold War Veterans Exemption." This local law clarifies the application of the Cold War Veterans Exemption within the Village of Williston Park.

Section One. There is hereby added to the Village Code of the Incorporated Village of Williston Park, a new Chapter 202 which shall be entitled “Homestead Base Proportions and Non-homestead Base Proportions,” which shall read as follows:

**Chapter 202**

**Homestead Base Proportions and  
Non-homestead Base Proportions.**

Section 202-1. Homestead Base Proportions and Non-homestead Base Proportions.

A. The provisions of § 1903 of the New York State Real Property Tax Law concerning homestead base proportions and non-homestead base proportions are hereby adopted.

B. The homestead base proportions and non-homestead base proportions shall be established by resolution of the Incorporated Village of Williston Park Board of Trustees in accordance with the Rules of the State Board of Equalization and Assessment and shall apply to taxes levied on the 2012/2013 final assessment roll and to taxes levied on subsequent rolls until this local law shall be repealed.

C. This local law shall take effect immediately.

Section Two. This local law will be effective upon filing with the Secretary of State.

Section One. Chapter 201 of the Village Code of the Incorporated Village of Williston Park is hereby amended by adding thereto a new Article V, entitled “Recomputation of Eligible Funds Exemptions to Veterans Under RPTL § 458 After Revaluations and Updates, effective for 2012/2013 Final Assessment Roll,” which will read as follows:

### **Article V**

#### **Recomputation of Eligible Funds Exemptions to Veterans under RPTL § 458 After Revaluation Effective for 2012/2013 Final Assessment Roll**

Section 201-26.

A. After the Village has completed its revaluation and update of the 2012/2013 final assessment roll, the eligible funds exemptions granted to veterans in the Village under § 458 of the Real Property Tax Law shall be recomputed based on the change of level in

assessment as of the taxable status date for the 2012/2013 final assessment roll.

B. After the Village has completed its revaluation and update of the 2012/2013 final assessment roll, veterans who had previously received eligible funds exemptions under § 458 of the Real Property Tax Law but had switched to the alternative veterans exemption under § 201-25 of the Village Code, may switch back and receive the eligible funds exemption under § 458 of the Real Property Tax Law as recomputed with the change in level of assessment, provided that this switch back to the eligible funds exemption must be made within one year from the effective date of this local law.

Section Two. This local law will be effective upon filing with the Secretary of State.

Local Law No. 3 of the year 2011

Section One. Chapter 201, Article III, of the Village Code of the Incorporated Village of Williston Park is hereby amended to read as follows:

**ARTICLE III**  
**Senior Citizens Exemption**

§ 201-16. Effective Date.

The following provisions shall apply to assessment rolls prepared on the basis of taxable status dates occurring on and after January 1, 2012.

§ 201-17. Partial Exemption Granted

Real Property in the Village of Williston Park owned by one or more persons, each of whom is 65 years of age or over, or real property owned by husband and wife, one of whom is 65 years of age or over, shall be exempt from taxation by the Village to the extent of 50% of the assessed valuation thereof.

§ 201-18. Conditions.

No exemption shall be granted:

- A. Unless an annual application is made therefor, as hereinafter set forth.
- B. If, pursuant to New York Real Property Tax law § 467(3)(a), the income of the owner or the combined income of the owners of the property for the income tax year immediately preceding the date of making application for exemption exceeds the sum of \$29,000.
- C. Unless all other requirements of § 467 of the Real Property Tax Law, as amended, are complied with.

§ 201-19. Application for Exemption.

A verified application for the annual exemption shall be made by the owner, or all of the owners, of the property on forms prescribed by the State Board of Real Property Services to be furnished by the Assessor's office.

§ 201-20. Supporting Documents.

The owner, or all of the owners, shall file any supporting document the Assessor deems necessary.

§ 201-21. Deadline for Filing.

The application and the supporting documents shall be filed in the Assessor's office on or before the first day of January in each year. Notwithstanding the above or subdivision five of RPTL § 467, an application for an exemption under this Chapter may be filed with the Assessor after the appropriate taxable status date but not later than the third Tuesday of February, where failure to file a timely application resulted from: (a) a death of the applicant's spouse, child, parent, brother or sister; or (b) an illness of the applicant or of the applicant's spouse, child, parent, brother or sister, which actually prevents the applicant from filing on a timely basis, as certified by a licensed physician. The Assessor

shall approve or deny such application as if it had been filed on or before the taxable status date.

§ 201-22. Time Period for Filing.

The Assessor's office shall accept applications and supporting documents only during the month of December, except as provided in § 201-21.

§ 201-23. Filing of Law and Applications with Assessor.

The Assessor shall not amend the assessment rolls to reflect any exemption authorized by the Real Property Tax Law § 467 until a certified copy of the local law providing for such exemption is filed with the office of the Assessor. Applications and supporting documents for exemptions from Village taxes shall be filed with the Assessor in the same manner and within the time specified by § 201-22 of this article.

§ 201-24. Annual Notification.

At least 60 days prior to the first day of January in each year, the Assessor shall mail to each person who was granted exemption pursuant to this article on the latest completed assessment roll an application form and a notice that such application must be filed on or before such first day of January and be approved in order for the exemption to be granted. Such notice shall also contain or have attached a copy of § 201-21. Failure to mail any such application form and notice or the failure of such person to receive the same shall not prevent the levy, collection and enforcement of the payment of the taxes on property owned by such person.

Section One. Chapter 201, Article IV, Section 201-25(B) is hereby renumbered as Section 201-25(B)(i).

Section Two. There is hereby added to Section 201-25(B), a new Section 201-25(B)(ii), which shall read as follows:

In addition to the exemption provided by § 201-25(B)(i), where the Cold War Veteran received a compensation rating from the United States Veterans Affairs or from the United States Department of Defense because of a service connected disability, qualifying residential real property shall be exempt from taxation to the extent of the product of the assessed value of such property, multiplied by fifty percent of the Cold War Veteran disability rating; provided, however, that such exemption shall not exceed Forty Thousand Dollars, or the product of Forty Thousand Dollars multiplied by the latest state equalization rate for the Village or the latest class ratio for the Village, if any, whichever is less.

Section One. Chapter 219, Article IV, Section 219-14(E) is hereby amended to read as follows:

E. Municipal Parking Lot No. 5.

The municipal parking lot on the southeast corner of Fordham Street and Willis Avenue will be available for parking of vehicles upon the following conditions:

- (i) Up to and including December 31, 2011:
  - (a) Not exceeding 90 minutes; and
  - (b) No commercial vehicles shall be allowed to enter, remain, stand or park in any part of the lot.
- (ii) Effective January 1, 2012:

- (a) No person shall park any automobile or any other vehicle in any part of the westerly portion of said parking lot for more than 90 minutes in any one day from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.;
- (b) No person shall park any automobile or other vehicle in such parking lot from 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. unless such person shall have first obtained from the Village Clerk of the Incorporated Village of Williston Park, a permit therefor as provided in Chapter 93, Fees, of the Village Code or, having obtained such permit, for a period of more than 18 continuous hours in any one day;
- (c) No commercial vehicles shall be allowed to enter, remain standing, or park in any part of this parking lot; and
- (d) No person shall park any automobile or other vehicle in the easterly portion of such parking lot from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. unless such person shall have first obtained from the Village Clerk of the Incorporated Village of Williston Park a permit therefor as provided in Chapter 93, Fees, of the Village Code or, having obtained such permit, for a period of more than 18 continuous hours in any one day.

Section Two. This local law will be effective as of January 1, 2012, and upon filing with the Secretary of State.
